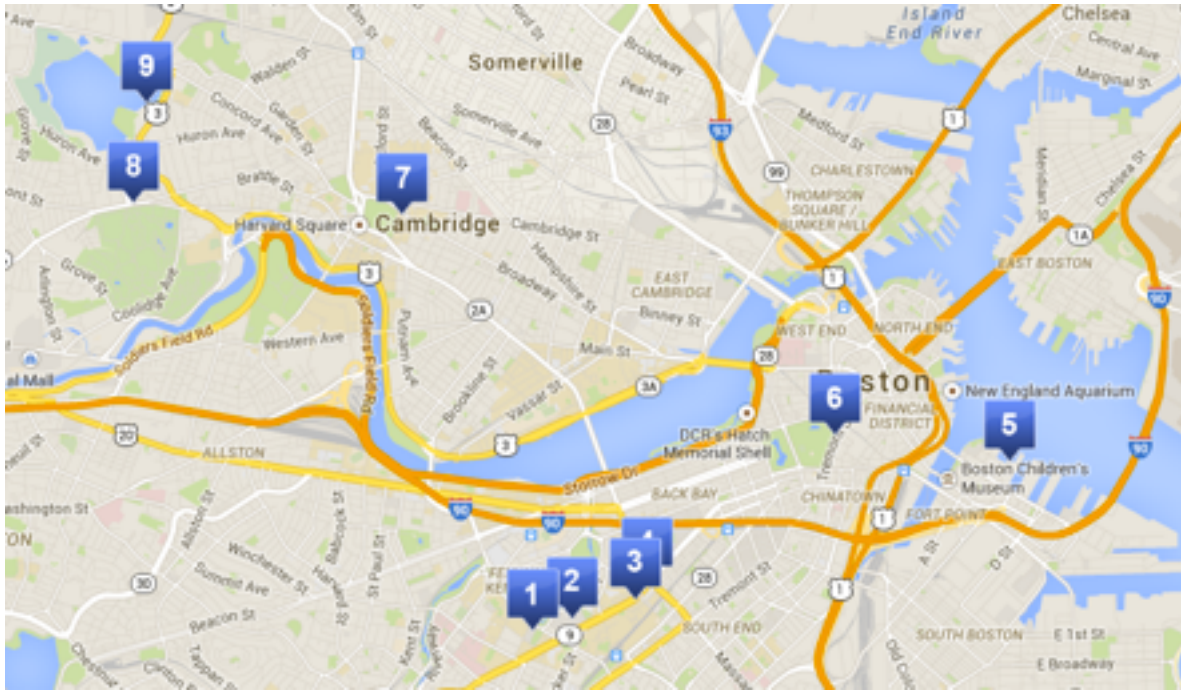

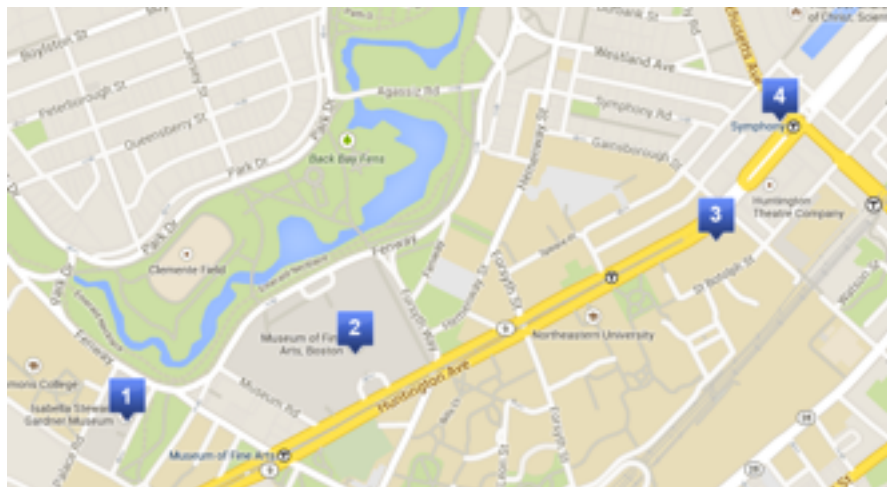

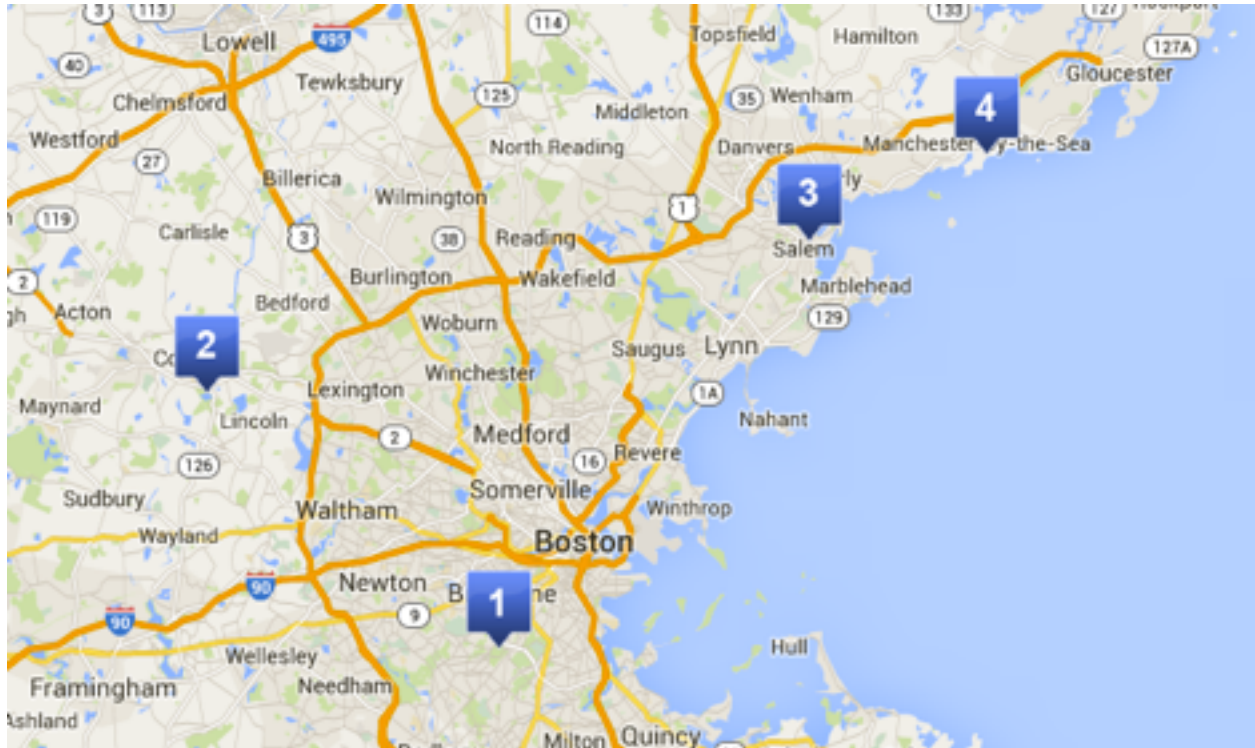
## Hearing Landscape Critically Boston/Cambridge Map
